A note from AARHMS President, James Brodman.

The six months during which I have been privileged to serve as president of AARHMS have been active, even hectic at times. Through the courtesy of Lynn Nelson, the University of Kansas has provided facilities for an AARHMS HomePage, which I installed during August and September. Currently, it contains some information about AARHMS, an archive of previous issues of the Newsletter, and links to various sites on the Internet that I hope will be of use to members. Planned for the future is an archive of book reviews and course syllabi, and a collection of bio-bibliographies of prominent American Hispanists. The "logo" and illustrations were provided by Lynn Nelson, who again deserves our appreciation. In addition, there is an interactive recruitment form which, to date, has produced eighteen inquiries for membership. I am especially pleased at the effectiveness of the Internet in reaching those who are just entering our field of study. Because a useful HomePage must be a cooperative effort, I encourage suggestions -- both specific and general -- for improvements and additions. During the course of the summer, because of the press of his many other commitments, Don Kagay resigned as editor of the Newsletter. He has our collective thanks for the marvelous job that he did improving the graphic appearance of our publication. Subsequently, Clifford Backman "volunteered" to take up the task and at short notice has taken charge, promising several enhancements to the services that we provide to members. Among these is an interest in reviving our tradition of doing reviews for new books. The plan is to publish these first in the Newsletter, and then to provide a permanent archive on the HomePage. For this to be more than an occasional endeavor, we will need the services of a book review editor. If anyone is interested in this duty, please contact me by the end of January 1996. In a related manner, for some time Lynn Nelson has made available to us our own Internet discussion list. I encourage every member, even those who avoid other lists, to become a subscriber. You can do so by sending an e-mail message to: listserv@ukanaix.cc.ukans.edu with the message: sub aarhms-l yourlastname. Initially, I would like to use aarhms-l to distribute the Newsletter electronically, and for the occasional announcement to the membership. Beyond that, I am open to suggestions. For example, we might use it for an international, electronic conference on a particular subject.

At the January meeting, I would like to propose a minor amendment to our constitution that would create an Executive Board. The members would include the Elected Officers (the President and the Secretary/Treasurer), the immediate past president, the editor of the Newsletter, the book review editor, and a graduate student

representative (to be selected by the Board). I believe that this structure would provide a broader base for planning, and provide a measure of continuity between regimes.

Finally, it is time to plan for the next series of conventions. Theresa Vann has graciously agreed to serve as Program Chair for the 1997 sessions at Kalamazoo. Those who are interested in that meeting should contact Theresa by early summer. The 1997 meeting of the American Historical Association will be held in New York City. If anyone would care to serve as Program Chair for this meeting, kindly contact me. In the meanwhile, those interested in proposing individual papers or entire sessions may send them to me (along with the vita required by the AHA. Graduate students are particularly encouraged to participate.
